**Position Summary:** Provide maintenance, grounds keeping and security for the preservation of CMN facilities and grounds and the safety of students, staff, faculty and visitors to CMN. Hours may vary at times based on departmental and campus needs.

# **Position Responsibilities & Duties:**

- Maintenance Technician (50%)
- Develop annual plans and scheduling for light fixtures, flooring and carpet maintenance and facilities operational equipment
- Operate snow plowing and other heavy equipment as directed
- Perform room setup and furniture movement as scheduled
- Perform mail run and other transportation services as requested
- Maintain clear and unobstructed entrances for all buildings and facilities
- Perform minor repairs and replacement of plumbing and/or electrical equipment and fixtures
- Maintain inventory records and ensure security and tracking of supplies and equipment
- Maintain campus preservation of interior and exterior surfaces; reporting potentially unsafe/hazardous conditions
- Groundskeeper (25%)
- Conduct brush and snow removal, raking, seeding and other grounds maintenance activities
- Maintain safety, security and working order of lawn and gardening equipment and supplies
- Maintain campus ground with litter and trash removal
- Security (25%)
- Perform regular patrol of campus and facilities to ensure security and visibility
- Participate in the advancement of safety and security procedures
- Respond to safety and security alarms when contacted by telephone/text/email
- Participate in emergency responses for persons and campus property
- Provide limited staff/student/visitor campus escort services as requested
- Prepare and maintain regular accurate incident and security reports
- Serve on campus Emergency Response Team, maintaining CPR and First Aid Certifications
- Other duties as assigned.
