POSITION SUMMARY

Under direct supervision of the Food & Beverage Supervisor, serve beverages/food to the guests in a friendly, courteous and timely manner, resulting in guest's satisfaction. Prepares beverages for other servers to supply to guests and act as a cashier for the lounge. Maintains confidentiality of all privileged information. Continuation of this position is contingent upon funding allocations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Provide excellent customer service for all internal and external customers of the Food and Beverage operations at all times and in all activities. Provide solutions for customer concerns and continually focus on customer service as our top priority.
- 2. Develop, maintain, and facilitate effective relationships, communications processes and activities with all Gaming personnel and all other internal and external customers. Attend department meetings to ensure effective communications take place.
- 3. Inform supervisor of recommendations/ideas for improving all areas of this position.
