

Menominee Descendant Register Benefits

- 1. **Medical Assistance**: Indian Health Services for Hospitalizations and Tribal Clinic use Apply at local HIS facility. For further information call 715-799-3361.
- 2. **Housing Services:** Apply with Menominee Tribal Housing. For further information, call 715-799-3236.
- 3. Wisconsin Indian Student Assistance Grant: Awards under this program are made to Wisconsin residents who are at least 25% Native American and are undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in degree or certificate programs at University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Technical College, independent colleges and universities, tribal colleges, or proprietary institutions based in Wisconsin. - 4. Hunting, Fishing and Gathering Privileges: Registered Descendants possessing at least 1/8 degree Menominee Indian blood and who are listed on the Menominee Indian Tribe's Descendant Register per Ordinance No. 09-18. Editor's Note: See Ch. 46 Descendant Register. Fee information call License and Permits at 715-799-5142, for rules and regulations contact the Menominee Conservation Department at 715-799-5116.
- 5. Food Distribution: Descendants who are listed on the Menominee Indian Tribe's Descendant Register per Oridinance No. 09-18 can participate in the Food Distribution Programs on Indian Reservations (FDPIR). The Menominee Tribe of Wisconsin's Food Distribution Program may allow households residing on the reservation land or in approved near areas, and meeting all other non-financial and financial eligibility criteria to receive FDPIR benefits. Apply at your local Food Distribution Office. For further information, call 715-799-5131.
- Employment: Descendants who are listed on the Menominee Indian Tribe's Descendant Register per Ordinance No. 09-18, are recognized and allocated points in the employment selection process with the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin. For further information, call 715-799-5145.
