SCOPE OF WORK:

Responsible for serving as maintenance laborer, cleanup, and replacement worker for all non-operator positions throughout the plant.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Must have the knowledge, skills, and ability to perform the following:

- 1. Plant wide cleanup including using the mobile equipment as needed.
- 2. Identify worn or broken parts.
- 3. Using hand tools.
- 4. Serve as backup or replacement for any entry level manufacturing position.
- 5. Perform errands in getting supplies, equipment, and assisting maintenance.
- 6. Ability to clean at various heights and levels.
- 7. Accept training for future equipment operation to become a Skilled Utility Worker.
- 8. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work in extreme hot, cold, noisy, dusty work environment. Must be able to lift up to 75 lbs. Must wear appropriate safety apparel and equipment and comply with all safety policies and practices of MTE.
